### **June 1, 2016**

Meeting called to order at 6:05pm.

Robin has applied for a grant for the pool covers from CEDC. We will not find out about their decision until mid-June. If we are awarded the grant we will be committed to an ongoing saving plan towards the replacement of the covers throughout the years. The committee agreed to save 10% of the anticipated replacement cost in a savings account towards the future replacement of the covers.

The pool will officially open on June 13<sup>th</sup>, possibly on June 10<sup>th</sup> after school gets out if the pool is ready. Swimming lesson registration will be held June 13<sup>th</sup>- June 17<sup>th</sup> with lessons beginning on Monday, June 20<sup>th</sup>. The Rec center will open on Monday, June 13<sup>th</sup> will regular hours and programming. The pool and Rec Center will both close on Friday, August 19<sup>th</sup>.

The 4<sup>th</sup> of July Pool Party will be held on Tuesday, July 5<sup>th</sup>. This will be a fundraising event to help raise funds for the replacement of pool covers as well as other program supplies/activities.

Liza will inventory the pool supplies and get a list to Kerry as to what needs to be ordered and purchased. Wanda will pick up the food & drinks that will be sold at the Rec Center.

Liza will coordinate with the local newspapers again to run an article regarding the pool and the staff. She has also been in communication with the local EMT's and they would like to conduct a drill sometime this summer to test the lifeguards and ambulance crew skills in the event of a water rescue. She may also try to coordinate a first aid course to be held at the pool for kids to take.

All lifeguards who obtain certifications this year should submit their receipt and proof of certification to the town office to receive a 50% reimbursement.

Due to only have two certified WSI instructors this year, these two instructors will have significant additional responsibilities. The committee decided to offer the two WSI instructors an additional \$300.00 bonus at the end of the season, providing a satisfactory work performance.

The 8<sup>th</sup> grade would like to use the pool on June 9<sup>th</sup> for a class party. GHS staff will contact lifeguards about working for the day.

The committee decided to hire Katelin Rodden and Khaley Styles to share the vacant Arts & Crafts position at the Rec Center. Both Katelin and Khaley will work PT and will be paid \$7.25 per hour working alternating weekly schedules of Mon, Wed & Friday or Tues & Thurs.

All staff members will be required to submit requested days off to Kerry in advance and will be responsible for finding their own substitute for their shift.

Tracie and the Rec staff will be working on June 10<sup>th</sup> @1pm to clean and set up the Rec Center.

Kerry will make flyers regarding the program hours and schedule of events and Wanda will distribute throughout the elementary school.

Wanda will give all salary amounts and applications to Becky at the Town Office.
