



## WEEKLY PICK-UP

### RECYCLABLES IN BLUE BOX—Cleaned and Crushed

Material	What to recycle	How to prepare	DO NOT Include
<b>PLASTICS</b>	Containers labeled with a  PET or  HDPE on the bottom. All soda and milk bottles, even if not numbered.	Remove caps and any metal rings. Drain, Rinse and Crush.	Containers which have wide mouths, <b>no seams down the side</b> , and a nipple in the center of the base (example-yogurt containers); toys, and plastic bags.
<b>CANS Aluminum and Tin</b>	Beverage containers, clean pie plates, aluminum foil, food and soup cans, <b>dried</b> paint cans.	Empty, Clean and Crush. Labels OK.	Food or liquids, non-aluminum lids.

**WHEN IN DOUBT—LEAVE IT OUT!!!**

**STORAGE PROBLEM?** You can: 1. Obtain extra blue recycling containers from the town office for \$5 each.  
2. Drive to the Transfer Station during operating hours.

### IN SEPARATE UNCOVERED CONTAINER

<b>GLASS</b>	All Glass	Clean and Rinse. <b>REMOVE</b> covers and lids from containers.	
<b>OTHER CONTAINERS</b>			
<b>HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH</b>	Containers no larger than 30 gallons.	Covered or Bagged.	<b>NO RECYCLABLES, GLASS, CORRUGATED CARDBOARD OR NEWSPAPERS.</b>
<b>NEWSPAPER</b>	Newspapers only. Sunday inserts and comics OK.	Clean and Dry Only. Tie in bundles with string (no wire) or pack in brown paper grocery bags.	No catalogs, junk mail, books, magazines, cardboard, or office paper.
<b>CARDBOARD</b>	Brown, double-walled corrugated cardboard (OCC).	Clean and dry, flattened and bundled. Remove staples and tape.	No cereal, shoe, detergent boxes. No wet or dirty cardboard. No staples or tape.

### OTHER MATERIALS

#### You Transport to Transfer Station to Designated Area

<b>METAL</b>	All scrap metals including appliances.	All non-metal parts removed.	No wood, rubber, or plastic parts.
<b>TIRES</b>	Rubber tires.	Removed from rims.	No rims.
<b>USED OIL</b>	Used engine oil and transmission oil.	Empty into designated area.	No transformer oil.
<b>BATTERIES</b>	Wet cell auto-type batteries.	Place in designated area.	No household batteries.
<b>DEMOLITION DEBRIS AND BULKY ITEMS</b>	Furniture and building materials.	Place in designated open top container.	
<b>LEAVES AND YARD WASTE</b>		Place in designated area.
